**6. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Mayor Jayroe recognized Ms. Sallie Parker. Ms. Parker stated there are many

animals in the City that are chained to one spot. She said this is known in other parts of the country as tethering and is considered cruelty and is against the law. Ms. Parker stated it is time for the City to keep up with the nation and make this against the law. Ms. Parker read excerpts from laws written in other states. Ms. Parker submitted a petition to Mayor Jayroe asking to free animals from tethering and for the City to enforce the law.

Mayor Jayroe recognized Ms. Janette Graham. Ms. Graham referenced a newspaper article that listed the breakdown of ARPA funds and stated all areas of Georgetown were not represented equally in the list.

Mayor Jayroe recognized Ms. Jacqueline Williams. Ms. Williams stated she represents the State of South Carolina AFL-CIO, the local NAACP branch, and the Faith and Labor Roundtable. Ms. Williams referenced an article in the Post & Courier about Liberty Steel. She stated on Tuesday, the mill began running steel. Ms. Williams said she is unaware of a meeting being scheduled at this time. She stated she will be officially requesting a meeting with City officials and the groups she is representing to discuss the future of Liberty Steel and any plans or intentions for the dredging of the Port.
