WHEREAS, Broad Street is located within the City of Georgetown and is being developed into an additional gateway onto Front Street from Church Street/Highway 17; and

WHEREAS, both Broad Street denoted as S-379 and Church Street denoted as US Hwy. 17 N/S are under the SC Department of Transportation state system for maintenance and control; and

WHEREAS, vehicles traveling southbound on Hwy. 17, attempting to turn left onto Broad Street experience difficulty in light of the high traffic volumes northbound; and

WHEREAS, turning movements onto Broad Street that are increasing in number, have a higher potential for accidents due to the high traffic volumes in both north and southbound lanes of Church Street; and

WHEREAS, installation of a traffic signal allowing protection turns from southbound Church Street/Hwy. 17 would have both safety and convenience benefits to motorists; and

WHEREAS, installation of a traffic signal would have benefits for pedestrian traffic crossing Broad Street at its intersection with Church Street; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council recognize the importance of providing safe streets for pedestrians and drivers alike in the City of Georgetown.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council request the South Carolina Department of Transportation to consider installation of a traffic signal at the intersection for the convenience and safety of the pedestrian and motoring public in the City of Georgetown.
