3. PRESENTATION

A. Solid Waste Management Services Rate Study

Ms. Mihaela Coopersmith from Raftelis presented the Solid Waste Management Services Rate Study that was recently completed. Ms. Coopersmith explained the overview of the project included a solid waste financial plan and rates and fees. She reviewed how to design a rate structure. She stated this year is the first time rates have been increased in twenty years. She stated our vehicles are old and need replaced. Ms. Coopersmith reviewed the study results and pointed out recommendations and next steps needed. Discussions followed.

B. MASC Annexation Presentation

Mr. Charlie Barrineau from the Municipal Association of South Carolina presented municipal annexation. Mr. Barrineau reviewed the politics of annexation. He gave an overview of the benefits of annexation to the property owner and to the municipality. Mr. Barrineau showed examples of annexation with maps and illustrations and explained different scenarios. Mr. Barrineau reviewed the legalities of annexation and explained the current legislation.
